Assessment of Lab 1 - 4 will be in the form of a 15-minutes oral examination for each student on Thursday 8th of June 2017 from 2.00pm to 5.45pm. A schedule for the examination is shown below. This is a formal assessment and you are REQUIRED to be present. Due to the tight schedule, please be in the Lab at least 15 minutes before your allotted time.

The purpose of the Oral examination is to establish how much you have learned from these Lab Sessions. You are not required to memorize anything. You can bring along any materials, for example your notes and the laboratory instruction documents. YOU MUST BRING YOUR ELECTRONIC LOGBOOK WITH YOU. The Oral Examination will take place in EEE Lab, Level 1 EEE Building.
